Social Studies	People, places, and events in the local community, and in local First Peoples communities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• People (ie, political leaders like the mayor or band council, school officials, local business people)• Places (ie, school, neighbourhoods, stores, parks, recreation facilities)• Events (ie, new buildings, seasonal changes, sports)• Natural and human-built characteristics of the local physical environment <p>Key question: What people, places, or events are most significant to you? Is your list the same as your classmates or family?</p>
Math	Draw upon local First Peoples' knowledge and/or expertise of local Elders to make connections to mathematical topics and concepts
