



TERMS OF REFERENCE

ENHANCING STUDENT LEARNING COMMITTEE

Purpose

To work to continuously improve student learning for each student, and to address differences in performance amongst particular groups of students.

Terms of Reference

- To annually review school, district and provincial student performance evidence.
- To identify, based on student performance evidence, one goal in each of the following areas: intellectual, human/social, and career/skill development.
 - To identify evidence-based actions to be taken in support of each goal.
 - To set performance objectives connected to each goal.
 - To monitor progress towards meeting performance objectives.
- To develop a three-year plan that articulates goals, actions, and objectives.
 - Plan to be updated annually.
 - Plan to be reported publically.
 - Plan to be approved by the Board of Education in October of each year.
- To review school Enhancing Student Learning plans annually.
- To liaise with the Parents of Students of Aboriginal Ancestry Focus Group and the Parents of Students with Special Needs Focus Group.
- Committee to be chaired by a member of the District Staff.
